Candy Canes

Candy canes are one of the most popular treats during the holiday season. In fact, nearly 1.76 billion candy canes are made each year. Most candy canes (90%) are sold between Thanksgiving and Christmas. There is even a day to celebrate candy canes! December 26th is known as "National Candy Cane Day."

Candy canes were first introduced to America in 1847 by a German-Swedish immigrant named August Imgard. He decorated the Christmas tree with paper ornaments and candy canes.

Most people are used to seeing red and white candy canes. However, candy canes used to be just white. In the early 1900s, red stripes were added! Candy canes are now available in different shapes, colors and flavors, but the red and white peppermint candy cane still remains the classic favorite among candy canes.
