Modal Verbs Uses



Uses

1. to ask for something politely : **could, may**
2. to offer to do something: **can, would**
3. to express a strong advice: **had better**
4. absence of obligation: **needn't, don't have to**
5. to express preferences: **would rather**
6. to express obligation: **have to, must**
7. to be accustomed to doing something: **be used to**
8. to give advice: **should, ought to**
9. to express possibility: **may, might**
10. to express future predictions: **will**
11. to become accustomed to doing something: **get used to**
12. to express necessity: **need**
13. to express habits or routines in the past: **used to**
14. to express prohibition: **mustn't**
